- 5) *External assessment of P3DP activities in Ukraine* (P3DP, 2012-2015) - analysis of P3DP performance indicators and Workplan implementation.
Scope of work: quarterly collection of information on the project performance indicators from P3DP managers; supporting the database of projects and documents; analysis of the data obtained; writing and presentation of summary reports.
- 6) *Academic Inbreeding in Ukraine* (CEHI, Boston College, 2013-2014) - a study of academic inbreeding in Ukraine, its causes and its impact on the labour market and academic environment.
Scope of work: based on the survey data, an econometric estimation (in Stata) of the probability of inbreeding and the difference in salary and quality of inbred and non-inbred faculty was

performed.

- 7) *Relationship between education and migration in Ukraine* (ILO, 2012) - investigating the relationship between educational attainment and migration characteristics of Ukrainians.
Scope of work: literature review; analysis of the main migration trends in Ukraine based on descriptive statistics; analysis of the main features of education system in Ukraine.
- 8) *Cost and Benefits of Labour Mobility between EU and Ukraine* (CASE, 2012) - evaluation of the effect of easing EU visa regime on Ukraine-EU migration.
Scope of work: review of relevant scientific papers, analysis of macroeconomic situation (historical trends and current developments) in Ukraine based on State Statistical Service data; analysis of historical and current labour migration trends.
- 9) *The Impact of the Global Financial Crisis on Education in Ukraine* (UNESCO, 2011) - analysis of the impact of 2008 financial crisis on financial stance of secondary schools and their students in Ukraine
Scope of work: description of Ukrainian educational system – it's main features and challenges it faces; processing survey data; drafting the final research report.
- 10) *Impact of school size on education performance* (Worldbank, 2011): literature review, processing of large data arrays in Excel
