## SUMMARY

The Kyiv School of Economics, founded by EERC and the Victor Pinchuk Foundation, came long way to becoming a Ukrainian world-class academic institution since it was first established in 1996. Currently KSE offers internationally recognized two-year, full time English language Master's Programs in Economic Analysis and in Financial Economics. The program's curriculum is modeled on the best economic graduate programs in North America and Western Europe.

During the past 13 years, KSE has produced **462 graduates**. **Seventy-two** graduates have already received a Ph.D. degree from Western universities; **10** of those graduates teach at KSE on full- or part- time basis.

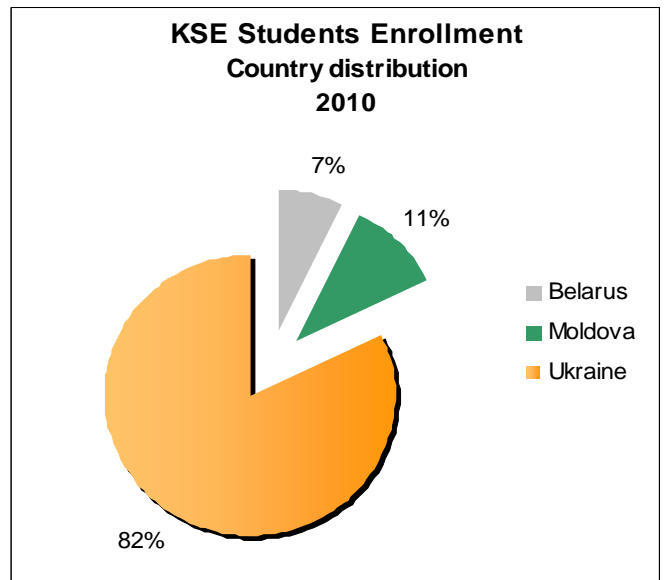
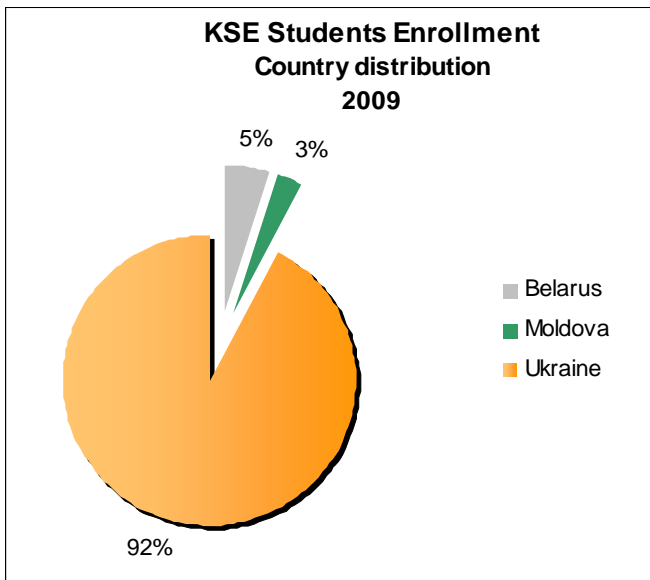
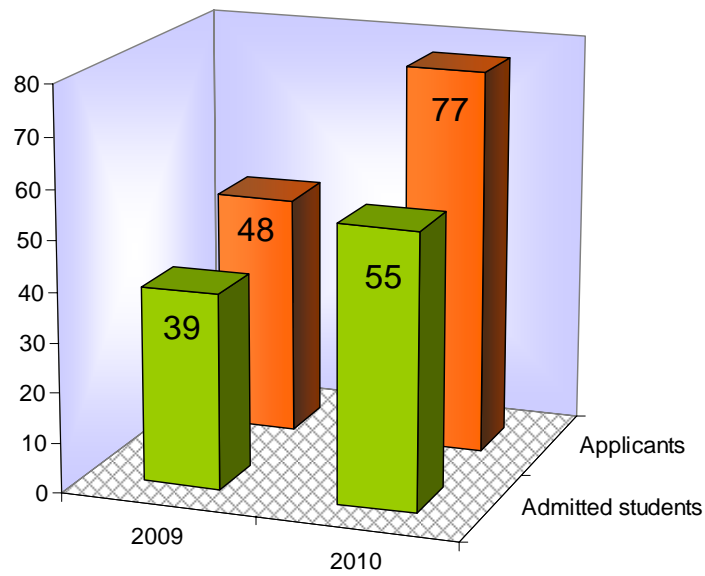
KSE alumni work in leading positions at the top financial and policy-making institutions in Ukraine, or earned recognition as excellent economists in the USA and Western Europe.

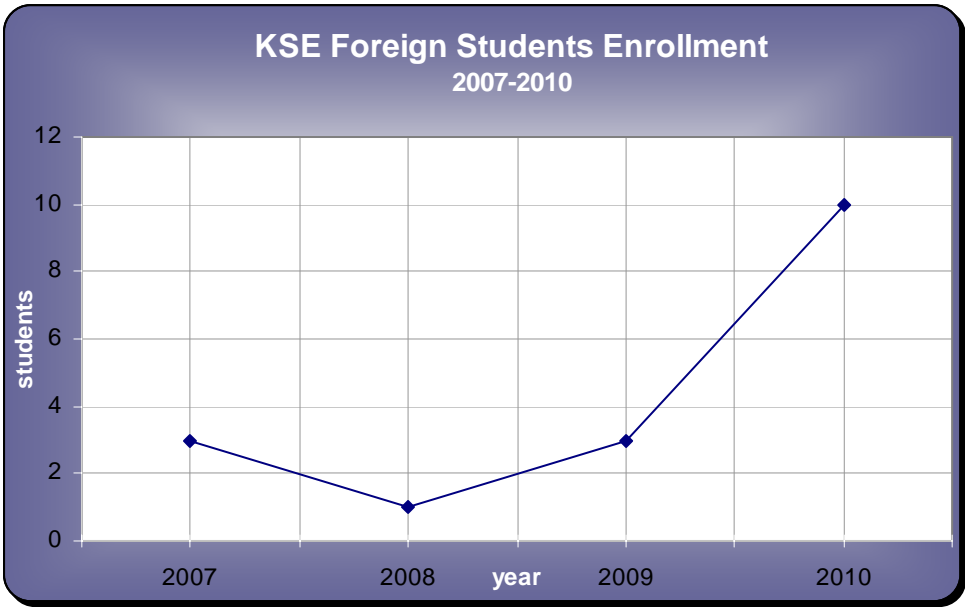
This year KSE admitted **55 new students**, **10** of whom are international students from Belarus and Moldova.

The school now has **11 permanent international and Western-trained Ukrainian faculty**, who both engage in teaching and conduct academic research. Most of our faculty have joint research projects with well-known US and European institutions, such as the University of Houston, University of Pittsburgh, Stockholm School of Economics, York University, CERGE, as well as the World Bank. During the last five years, our faculty published over **30 articles** in peer-reviewed journals. After graduation, KSE students receive **Master's Degree in Economics from the University of Houston** accredited in the US and recognised around the world.

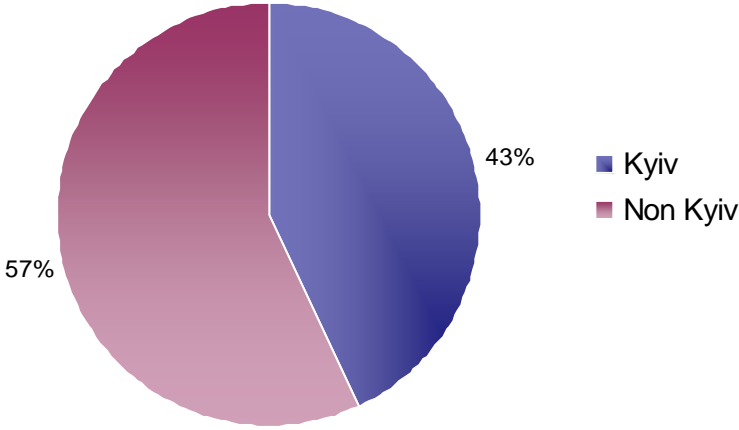

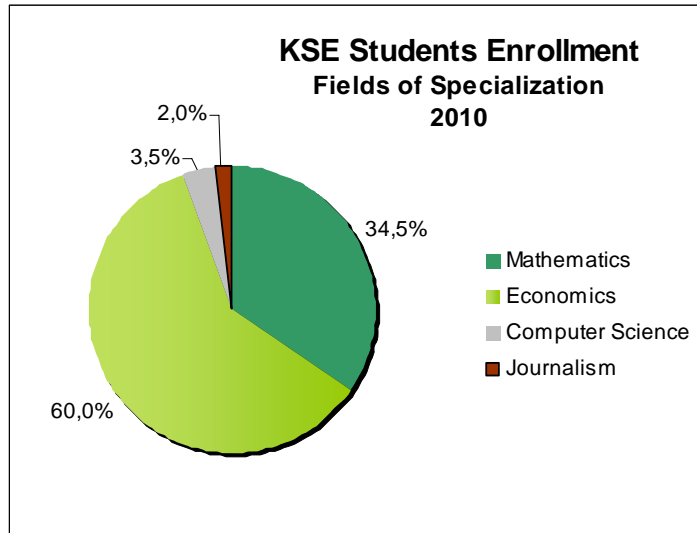
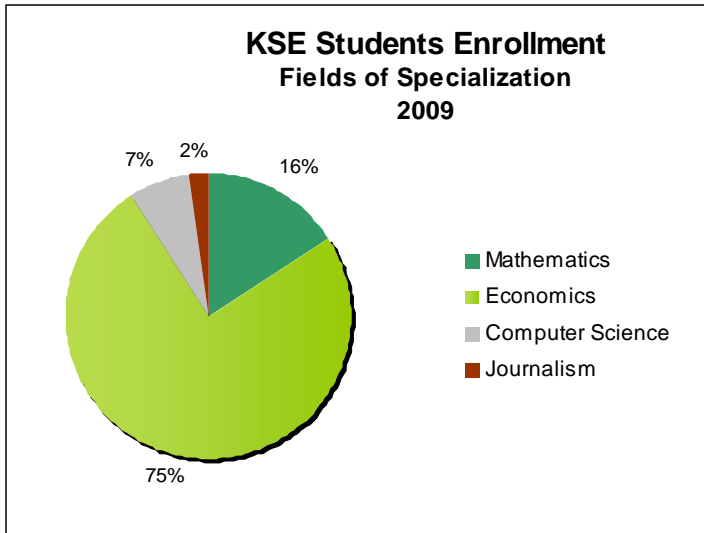
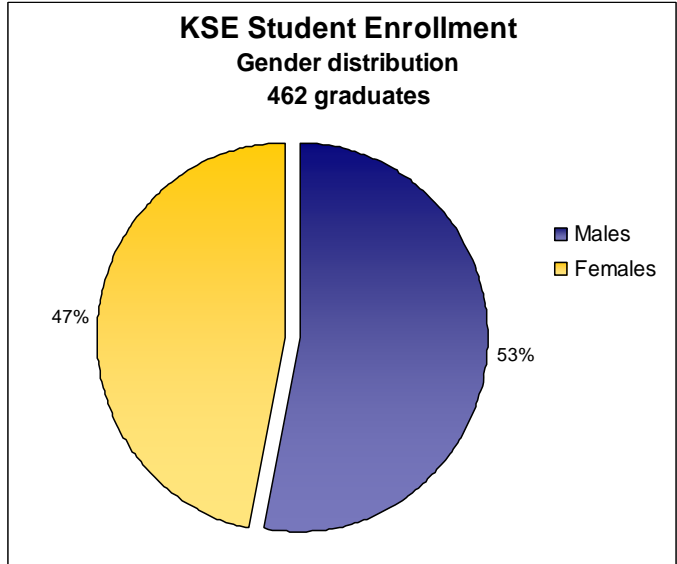
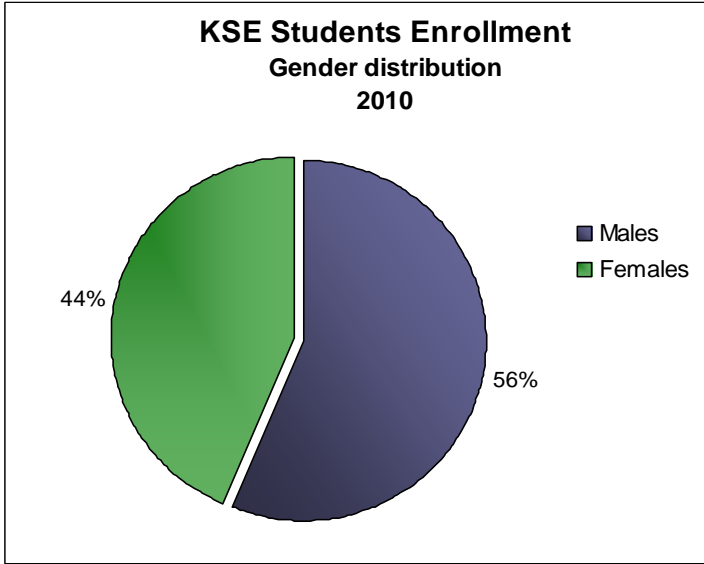
### KSE Students Applications and Enrollment 2009-2010



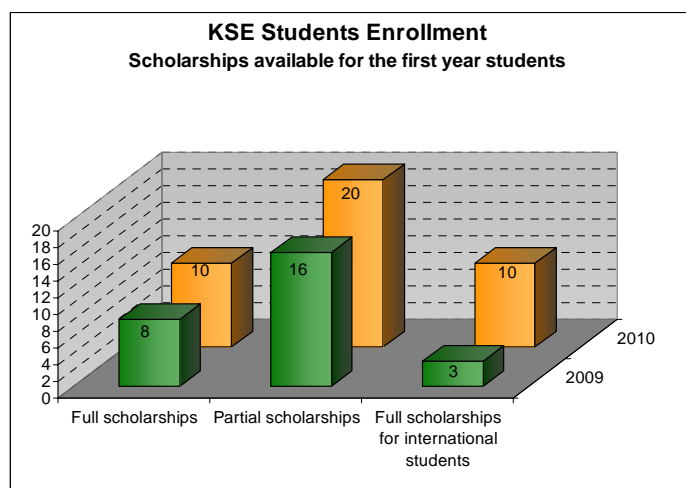
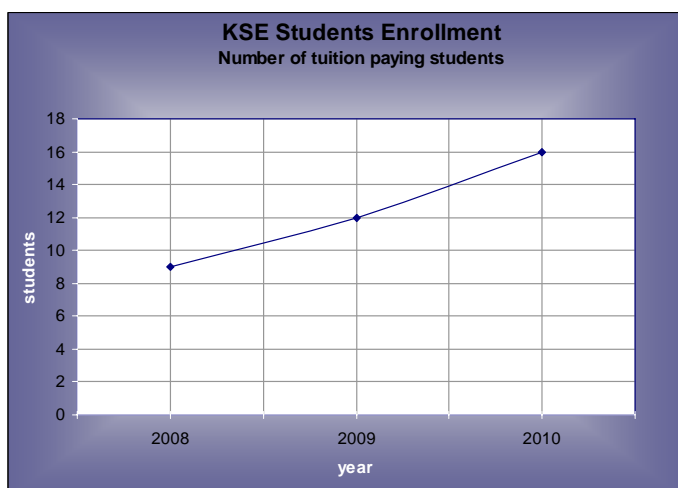
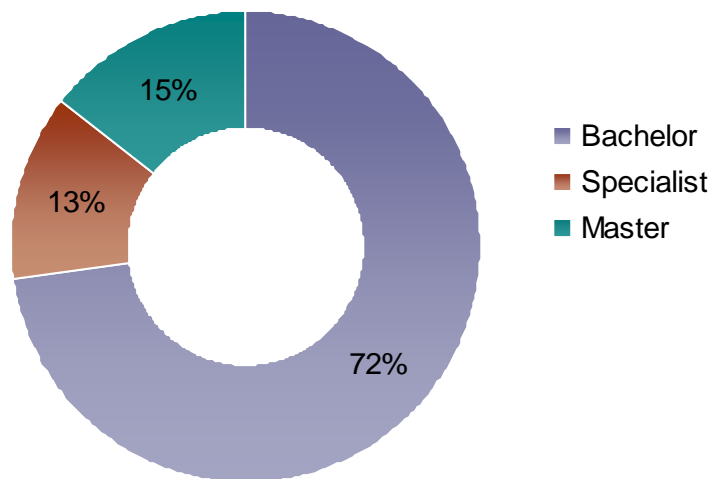


**KSE Students Enrollment
